

COVID-19 HEALTH & EVENT CANCELLATION POLICY

It's been two years since IBAO hosted our last in person event because of the COVID-19 pandemic. While things have improved since then, IBAO is opening our event doors in 2022 with caution. **Here are our rules for engagement:**

- 1. **General Health**: Delegates who are not feeling well or experiencing COVID-19 symptoms are asked not to attend the event in person. Should you be feeling unwell, please see our cancellation policy below.
- **2. Masking**: Masking at IBAO events is optional for all delegates and facilitators. IBAO events will remain a mask-friendly environment and we ask that all delegates be supportive of everyone's individual choices.
- **3. Vaccinations**: IBAO strongly encourages all delegates to be fully vaccinated against the COVID-19 virus. We will not be checking proof of vaccination at the door of our events.
- **4. COVID-19 Rapid Tests**: IBAO staff will have a supply of COVID-19 rapid tests at the event location, available upon request.

- 1. If the registrant is unable to attend the event, please submit a written notice to IBAO at IBAO@andlogistix.com to be eligible for a refund.
- 2. Full refunds are available if cancellation is provided in writing prior to May 13, 2022.
- 3. No refunds are available if the cancellation is made after May 13, 2022. In extenuating circumstance, refunds may be considered on a case-by-case basis.
- 4. Should the registrant contract COVID-19 five days prior to the start of the event, the registrant is asked NOT to attend.
